In the framework provided by Article 51 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/794 on Europol, we are pleased to invite you to the 6<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Joint Parliamentary Scrutiny Group (JPSG) on the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Cooperation (Europol), which will take place on 22 - 23 March 2020 in Zagreb, Croatia.

The Meeting will have on its agenda a number of specific issues directly arising from the JPSG prerogatives according to Article 51 of the Europol Regulation, including a presentation by Catherine DE BOLLE, Executive Director of Europol.
