Answer:

The present value of the price supplements for electricity generation corresponds to the supplement of DKK 0.431 per kWh.

In a situation where the average market price of electricity in the period 2012 – 2021 is DKK 0.36, the present value of the price supplements will also correspond to the supplement component of the guaranteed price of DKK 0.793 per kWh. The Danish Energy Agency has estimated that a price of DKK 0.36 per kWh is a likely average price in the period 2012 – 2021.
