On 01/10/2019, the committee noted and agreed to declassify the rapporteur's introductory memorandum. It agreed to hold a hearing with up to three experts at a forthcoming meeting, to authorise the rapporteur to conduct a fact-finding visit to Madrid and Barcelona (Spain) (both subject to the availability of funds) and to request an opinion of the Venice Commission to clarify in which circumstances, if any, the European Convention on Human Rights allows the criminalization of calls by politicians or representatives of civil society for radical constitutional changes by peaceful means-including calls for independence or far-reaching autonomy for parts of the national territory. It agreed to send a questionnaire to national parliaments via the European Centre for Parliamentary Research and Documentation (ECPRD).
