We are honoured to invite you to the Inter-Parliamentary Conference for the Common Foreign and Security Policy and the Common Security and Defence Policy (CFSP/CSDP) on behalf of the National Assembly and the National Council of the Republic of Slovenia. The Conference will take place on 9 September 2021 as part of the parliamentary dimension of the Slovenian Presidency of the Council of the European Union.

While we would have liked to see delegation members attend the Conference in person, it will be held as a videoconference in view of the epidemiological situation.

The Conference will be a good opportunity to discuss the priorities of the EU common foreign and security policy, its position as a global actor in a multipolar world, the enhancement of regional partnerships with Western Balkan countries, and the integration of armed forces in the development of civil protection capabilities in the context of the Solidarity Clause.
