## Dear Chairs,

The Nordic-Baltic corner of Europe stands out as a role model in terms of regional security and cooperation. Despite our challenging geography given the land, sea, and air borders we share with Russia, and a rich variety of histories, cultures, and membership of multinational organisations among our countries, we have found a way to navigate these difficulties in pursuit of our collective security and defence goals. Today, the Nordic and Baltic nations are net security contributors in both their own regions and beyond. This productive collaboration has been fostered through the Nordic and Baltic Eight (NB8), a long-standing multilateral cooperation format.

However, the changing security situation due to hybrid and cyber threats alongside the pandemic and other global security trends impel us to intensify our dialogue within the NB8 format. We would therefore like to propose reviving the idea of holding meetings of the chairs of the Security and Defence Committees of the Parliaments of the Nordic Countries and the Baltic States. In the context of the current pandemic, we invite you to hold such a meeting through cutting-edge digital means in April–May 2021.

We believe that the continuity of the NB8 cooperation shall remain a key priority on our foreign and security policy agenda.
