Dear Colleague,

For many years now, the European Parliament has been celebrating International Women's Day (IWD) with a special event bringing together Members of the EP and Members of the national Parliaments from across the European Union.

Hence, on the occasion of the IWD 2021, the European Parliament's Committee on Women's Rights and Gender Equality (FEMM) would like to invite Members of the national Parliaments of the EU to attend an Interparliamentary Committee meeting on the theme:

"Women's empowerment and leadership in Covid times"

The Covid-19 crisis has highlighted the need for gender equality and women's economic empowerment in order to build resilient societies, boost rules of employment, social security and pensions for all women, especially in female dominated sectors, and more generally change models in the provision of care and value of work (including unpaid care work). At the same time, the necessity was confirmed of equal representation of women and men in leadership and the decision-making process when enacting and lifting measures in crises, as well as in all stages of the design, adoption and implementation of recovery plans.

On the margins of the International Women's Day, the hearing will set a good platform for the Committee and the European Parliament, together with the national Parliaments, to mark this day and will provide a global forum for an exchange of experiences and best practices in advancing women's empowerment during crises such as the one triggered by COVID-19.

We are therefore very pleased to invite up to four Members of the corresponding committee(s) of each national Parliament (two from each chamber in the case of bi-cameral Parliaments) to attend this event on **Thursday**, 4 March 2021, from 9.00 to 12.00 online.
