

The Congress of Deputies:

- 1. Condemns in the strongest possible terms the military actions perpetrated by the Russian Federation in Ukraine, which constitute a serious violation of international law and an unjustified aggression which undermines European security and stability.
- 2. Urges an immediate ceasefire and the complete withdrawal of the Russian army from Ukraine. Reaffirms its support and full respect for the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Ukraine and calls for returning to the Minsk agreements.
- 3. Expresses its utmost solidarity and affection for Ukraine and its people.

 Deplores the loss of human lives, conveys its profound grief for the victims and the unnecessary suffering of the population and extends this feeling to the Ukrainian community residing in our country.
- 4. Resolutely demands the Russian Federation to respect international law, lay down its arms and return to the path of diplomacy.

Likewise, the Congress of Deputies calls on the European Union to:

- 5. Provide the necessary financial and humanitarian assistance, in coordination with the whole of the international community, to Ukraine and to the Ukrainian people, as well as to step up its efforts as regards its humanitarian emergency response and to remind Russia of its obligation to observe international humanitarian law.
- 6. To adopt as soon as possible all the necessary measures to receive, in the best possible conditions, the refugees caused by this military attack.
- 7. To step up efforts to promote diplomatic endeavors aimed at de-escalation and peacekeeping.

Finally, the Congress of Deputies:

8. Calls on the Government to keep on making progress in the plan coordinated with the Autonomous Regions and Local Entities to receive Ukrainian refugees in our country.
