## **Annual Nordic United Nations Assembly**

Experts will take stock of the Sustainable Development Goals at the halfway mark of their implementation and discuss the implications of prevailing trends in multilateral development financing on the overall capacity to deliver on the 2030 Agenda.

Finally, a roundtable discussion provides an opportunity for parliamentarians to share experiences, delineate information gaps and explore potential for Nordic cooperation in the multilateral space.
